#### **IMPORTANT EVENT INFORMATION**

#### DATES:

Sunday July 9th to Thursday July 13th

#### WHO IS INVITED:

Players born in 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013 birth years.

#### LOCATION:

DeSales University, 2755 Station Ave, Center Valley, PA 18034

#### CAMP STAFFING AND STRUCTURE:

- The camp staff is made up of International Coaching Staff from some of the top clubs and academies from around the world.
- Goalkeepers will have their own Professional coach and work together then join in with the other players for the evening games.
- The expected coach to player ratio is approximately 1:15 for U9 to U12 and 1:18 for U13 to U18.
- Coaching Staff will be supplemented by camp counsellors to manage transfer from dorms to fields and lights out and player welfare.

#### **OUTLINE OF SCHEDULE:**

- **SUNDAY:** Player's check-in around 2pm, player meeting to go over schedule and expectations, then campers will have games in the evening.
- MONDAY: Sessions in the morning and afternoon, with evening games.
- **TUESDAY:** Sessions in the morning and afternoon, with evening games.
- WEDNESDAY: Sessions in the morning and afternoon, with evening games.
- THURSDAY: Morning games then check out around noon

Afternoon sessions will generally be lighter consisting of activities such as futsal. Breakfast, lunch and evening meal will take place before sessions with free time to relax for players after final games.

#### **COST AND INCLUSIONS:**

The total cost of this event will be \$975 per person and includes:

- ▷ 4 Nights of Accommodation
- ▷ 5 Days of Training/Activities
- ▷ 4 x Breakfast
- ▷ 3 x Lunch
- ▷ 4 x Dinner

- Non NCE Players will be required to purchase full black COE training kit of shirts, shorts, socks and white alternate shirt for game play.

#### **EXCLUSIONS:**

- ▷ Transportation to and from DeSales University.
- ▷ Any additional food/drink outside of scheduled meals.
- Players are required to bring FULL black Nike COE uniform and white NCE shirt. Non NCE players see above.

#### ARRIVAL AND CHECK IN

- Check in is generally after 2.00pm on the first day and departure will be before lunch on the final day
- Full details on times to check in, check out and location will be provided before the event and posted to the program web page.

#### PACKING LIST

- All information on what to bring can be found on the program web pages.
- Players will receive a voucher which is included in the camp fee to purchase the required camp kit from the soccer.com website.
- In addition to the full camp kit players will need their complete NCE black COE training kit and the white COE training shirt.

#### ACCOMMODATION

- The players are in twin rooms and pairs of twin rooms share a shower and toilet.
- · Players will find out roommates at camp check-in.
- The rooms do not have fridges but there is a fridge on site for medicines.
- Bedding is not provided by the university and all players will need their own bedding, pillows, and towels.
- All dorms are air conditioned.

#### MEDICAL NEEDS

- There will be a trainer at camp for player's medical needs.
- · Camp medical staff will store and administer medication if necessary.
- Please make NCE Staff aware of any medical issues prior to camp.
- All players are required to provide a completed NCE medical authorization form to participate on camp.

#### FOOD AND DIETARY NEEDS

- ALL dietary needs are catered for by the university. For those campers with severe allergies, we will ask
  you to make us aware of this before the event so we can then pass along the information to DeSales
  University.
- Non-perishable snacks & drinks can be kept in player's rooms.
- 3 meals a day are provided but we also have pizza in the evening which players can purchase by the slice.

#### MISCELLANEOUS

- A small amount of spending money for the week (\$20-40) is recommended to buy pizza in the evening or DeSales branded gear which is available.
- There are FREE laundry facilities on site, but players will need washing powder/liquid/pods and dryer sheets.
- Players are not allowed to leave campus during the residential camp.
- There is FREE Wi-Fi at the University and in the dorm rooms.

#### PARENTS AND SUPPORTERS' INVOLVEMENT

- Parents and supporters are allowed to watch the games in the evening at camp.
- Parents and supporters are not allowed into dorms after check in. In the case of an issue that requires
  urgent attention please contact an NCE member of staff.
